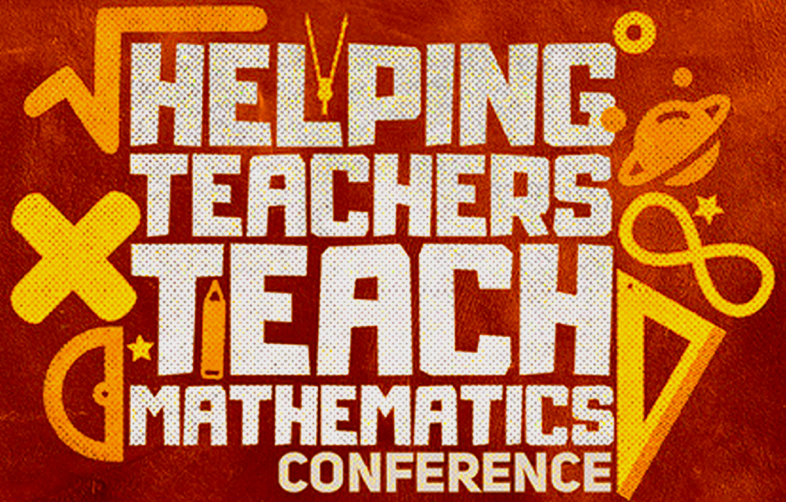

AIMS Ghana, a UNESCO Category II Centre of Excellence, aims to enhance mathematical sciences training for African high school teachers. To achieve this, AIMS Ghana is collaborating with the University of Waterloo's Centre for Education in Mathematics and Computing (CEMC) to organize a conference focused on innovative mathematics and computing teaching methods.
